

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WILSONVILLE, ALABAMA, AS
FOLLOWS:

That Ordinance No. 16-A, which was adopted and approved on December
28, 1960, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Said Ordinance was read at length, and thereupon Councilman
Charles Dillard moved that unanimous consent of the Council
be given for the immediate consideration of and action upon said Ordinance, which
motion was seconded by Councilman Reed W. Smith. Said motion for
unanimous consent was submitted to a vote of the Council and said vote resulted
as follows:
