

The Wilsonville Town Council met in a special meeting, Tuesday, August 30, 2016, in the Council Chamber Room at the Wilsonville Town Hall. Mayor Lee McCarty called the meeting to order at noon.

The following council members answered roll call: Don Davis, Calvin Gill, Patricia Johnson, Ricky Morris, Terry Newman. Dennis Blackerby and Larry Cohill were not present.

There was one Provisional Ballot voted at the election. The Shelby County Board of Registrars decision was not to count the ballot. The voter was not registered to vote at a Wilsonville address.
