

The Wilsonville Town Council met in regular session Monday, August 20, 2018, in the Council Chamber Room at the Wilsonville Town Hall. Mayor Lee McCarty called the meeting to order at 6:30 P. M.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Councilman Ricky Morris.

The following council members answered roll call: Richard Atchison, Larry Cohill, Gordon Fluker, Ivan Greene, Ricky Morris, Melissa Rosetta. Blake Ray was not present.

The minutes of the August 06, 2018, regular council meeting (mailed to the council members before this meeting) were reviewed.
