

The Wilsonville Town Council met Monday, June 21, 2021, in the Council Chamber Room at the Wilsonville Town Hall. Mayor Ricky Morris called the meeting to order at 6:30 P. M.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Councilwoman Melissa Rosetta.

Councilwoman Rosetta led the Pledge to Allegiance to the Flag.

The following council members answered roll call: Richard Atchison, Don Belcher, Mavis Cohill, Lauren Kennamer, Larry Lowe, Blake Ray, Melissa Rosetta.

The minutes of the June 07, 2021, regular council meeting (mailed to the council members before this meeting) were reviewed. Richard Atchison made a motion to approve the minutes, as presented; Lauren Kennamer seconded. The motion passed with the following vote: Richard Atchison, yes; Don Belcher, yes; Mavis Cohill, yes; Lauren Kennamer, yes; Larry Lowe, yes; Blake Ray, yes; Melissa Rosetta, yes.

Checks were examined by the council members immediately prior to the meeting. Blake Ray made a motion to approve the checks for mailing. Don Belcher seconded. The motion passed with the following vote: Richard Atchison, yes; Don Belcher, yes; Mavis Cohill, yes; Lauren Kennamer, yes; Larry Lowe, yes; Blake Ray, yes; Melissa Rosetta, yes.

Kelley Taft was not present at the meeting.

Monday, July 5th, the next scheduled council meeting date, is the designated holiday for July 4th. Richard Atchison made a motion the meeting be Tuesday, July 6th, instead; Mavis Cohill seconded. The motion was approved with the following vote: Richard Atchison, yes; Don Belcher, yes; Mavis Cohill, yes; Lauren Kennamer, yes; Larry Lowe, yes; Blake Ray, yes; Melissa Rosetta, yes.

The tree removal on Hebb Road was discussed. Richard Atchison stated he is against the Town removing the tree. Lauren Kennamer stated the tree is still alive and does not need to be removed and is on private property. Blake Ray is opposed to removing the tree; it would open the door for numerous requests for tree removal. Melissa Rosetta asked if the property owner has been sent a letter or otherwise contacted. No action was taken on the tree removal matter.

Mayoral Comments

The Annual God and Country Celebration will be Sunday, June 27th. There will be food, singing, and fireworks. If it rains, the food and singing will be moved inside the Wilsonville Baptist Church.

The mayor thanked Shelby County for trimming rights-of-way for us.

Council Comment

Mavis Cohill suggested changing garbage service to GFL, Green For Life, who pick up garbage, recycling, and debris (limbs, etc,) for a rate of \$18.00 per month. The City of Vincent is considering contracting with them.

Blake Ray suggested having a GFL representative come and talk to the council.

Melissa Rosetta asked about the weed abatement board. It is not listed on the committee and board list. She asked who is on that board. Larry Lowe said he thinks it is he and one town employee. This will be checked.

Don Belcher asked a letter be sent to Jimmer Bolden asking him to be in charge of the flag as Central Park.

There being no further business to come before the council, Richard Atchison made a motion to adjourn the meeting; Lauren Kennamer seconded. The motion received unanimous support.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:55 P. M.
