

The Wilsonville Town Council met Tuesday, September 06, 2022, in the Council Chamber Room at the Wilsonville Town Hall. Mayor Ricky Morris called the meeting to order at 6:30 P. M.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Councilwoman Melissa Rosetta.

Councilwoman Rosetta led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

The following council members answered roll call: Richard Atchison, Mavis Cohill, Lauren Kennamer, Larry Lowe, Blake Ray, Melissa Rosetta. Don Belcher was not present.

The minutes of the August 22, 2022, meeting (mailed to the council members before this meeting) were reviewed. Larry Lowe stated in the last paragraph of page one of the minutes, a correction needs to be made. Concerning the purchase of the fire truck, a certificate of deposit for about “sixth” per cent should be corrected to “sixty” per cent. Melissa Rosetta made a motion to approve the minutes with the necessary correction; Blake Ray seconded. The motion passed with the following vote: Richard Atchison, yes; Mavis Cohill, yes; Lauren Kennamer, yes; Larry Lowe, yes; Blake Ray, yes; Melissa Rosetta, yes.

Checks were examined by the council members immediately prior to the meeting.

Blake Ray made a motion to approve the checks for mailing; Larry Lowe seconded. The motion passed with the following vote: Richard Atchison, yes; Mavis Cohill, abstain; Lauren Kennamer, abstain; Larry Lowe, yes; Blake Ray, yes; Melissa Rosetta, yes.

Craig Viera, Business License Issue was the next item on the agenda. Mr. Viera was not in attendance.

Mayor/Council Comment

Blake Ray has spoken with Mr. Mitchell concerning the delivery of the storm shelter. Weather permitting, the shelter should be delivered either Thursday or Friday of this week.

Mavis Cohill stated the Christmas Parade Committee will be meeting Friday, September 16. This will be the same group as last year for the moment.

Mayor Morris said he is checking to see if he can get the Shelby County High School Choir to sing at the Christmas tree lighting ceremony this year.

Mayor Morris reported the applications are in for the Town Clerk job. Interviews will be scheduled.

Blake Ray mentioned an issue with limbs hitting school buses on Weldon Street and Brothers Avenue. The town clerk stated the limbs have been trimmed on Weldon Street; however, she is unaware of the Brothers Avenue location.

Larry Lowe asked if the FY2023 budget will be done by October.

Lauren Kennamer asked about the new truck which was recently purchased. It has not been put in service yet.

The mayor and the town clerk will be meeting with Mike Mitchell, Waste Management on Friday to discuss the upcoming contract.

Public Comment

Joyce Saxon stated she appreciated the Highway 61 paving. This was a Shelby County project, not the Town.

There being no further business to come before the council, Richard Atchison made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Larry Lowe seconded and the motion received unanimous approval.
