

The Wilsonville Town Council met Thursday, June 22, 2023, in the Council Chamber Room at the Wilsonville Town Hall. Mayor Ricky Morris called the meeting to order at 6:30 P. M.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Councilman Don Belcher.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilman Belcher.

The following council members answered roll call: Don Belcher, Lauren Kennamer, Larry Lowe, Blake Ray, Melissa Rosetta. Richard Atchison and Mavis Cohill were not present.

The minutes of the June 05, 2023, regular council meeting (mailed to the council members before this meeting) were reviewed. Larry Lowe made a motion to approve the minutes, as presented; Blake Ray seconded. The motion passed with the following vote: Don Belcher, yes; Lauren Kennamer, yes; Larry Lowe, yes; Blake Ray, yes; Melissa Rosetta, yes.

Checks were examined by the council members immediately prior to the meeting. Melissa Rosetta asked a question about the check to The Kelley Group. This should be the final check for the Highway 25 sidewalk project. Blake Ray made a motion to approve the checks for mailing; Lauren Kennamer seconded. The motion passed with the following vote: Don Belcher, yes; Lauren Kennamer, yes; Larry Lowe, yes; Blake Ray, yes; Melissa Rosetta, yes.

The representatives from Living Water Services were unable to attend the meeting tonight.

The God and Country Celebration was the next item on the agenda. The sandwiches/chips bags will be delivered at 5:30 P. M. The cost for the five-hundred bags was \$3,100.00. Blake Ray stated the church got enough donations to cover the entire cost of the fireworks.

Mayor/Council Comment

Larry Lowe asked about the door at the Revis Building. He will contact Overhead Door in Irondale and see if they will come and repair it.

Melissa Rosetta stated four-hundred families were served at the Food Bank Give Away this month.

Councilwoman Rosetta also said the library summer reading program is going well. The librarians are doing a great job.

Blake Ray asked if the paving on Valentine Circle is completed. Lore Foley said there is still equipment parked on Brothers Avenue; she thinks they are still working on Valentine Circle.

Melissa Rosetta asked about the applicants for the town clerk position. There have been several applications turned in.

There being no further business to come before the council, Larry Lowe made a motion to adjourn the meeting; Lauren Kennamer seconded. The motion received unanimous approval.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:39 P. M.
